

Previous PPE Regulation	Updated PPE Regulation (1/26/23 – 4/25/23)
HOSPITALS	
PPE Stockpile Methodology	
60 day PPE stockpile determined by formula: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single gloves - 15% x staffed beds x 550, • Gowns – 15% x staffed beds x 41, • Surgical masks - 15% x staffed beds x 21, • N95 respirator masks – 15% x staffed beds x 9.6 	Same formula BUT Commissioner can change it (see below)
Changes to Methodology	
	Adds that DOH will periodically determine the number of staffed beds in each hospital and may decide on an alternate bed calculation Adds that Commissioner may implement alternate methodology, including one developed by HHS
Commissioner may increase requirement from 60 days to 90 days during a PHE	
Off-Site Storage Allowed	
	Hospital meets PPE requirement if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • stored in off-site location within NYS • accessible within 24 hours • hospital maintains at least a 10- day supply on-site • vendor maintains unduplicated, facility-specific stockpile
Penalties	
Failure to comply may PPE may result in license revocation or suspension	
NURSING HOMES	
PPE Methodology	
60 day PPE stockpile determined by formula = positivity rate x number of certified nursing home beds as indicated on the nursing home’s operating certificate x (variable)	<u>Formula changed</u> = positivity rate x average census as determined annually by DOH x (variable)
Off-Site Storage Allowed	
	Hospital meets PPE requirement if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • stored in off-site location within NYS • accessible within 24 hours • hospital maintains at least a 10- day supply on-site • vendor maintains unduplicated, facility-specific stockpile
